Sunday Worship: Now that Thanksgiving is officially behind us, we in the church are entering the season of Advent... the 4-week time period before Christmas. Advent is a time of preparation...of preparing to celebrate the historical birth of Jesus while also preparing for his promised return. Part of this preparation involves decorating our homes... as well as the church.

One of my favorite decorations, if you will, are manger scenes. Whether they are simple or elaborate, they remind us of all that takes place from Gabriel’s visit with Mary all the way to the visit of the magi some time later.

This Advent season I want to invite you on a journey... a journey into a manger scene. During this season of Advent, I will be preaching a sermon series entitled, “Faces at the Manger.” This series will invite us to virtually enter the manger... take a look around at all the different faces and people... and discover the message they have for us. More than beautiful decorations during this season, manger scenes also offer us an invitation to enter the story of God’s love for us that we see played out in the birth of his son, Jesus Christ.

For this first week of Advent we will be exploring Luke 1:26-38, and the sermon title is “Faces at the Manger...Mary”. I hope to see you Sunday and don’t forget to invite your friends and neighbors to join you!

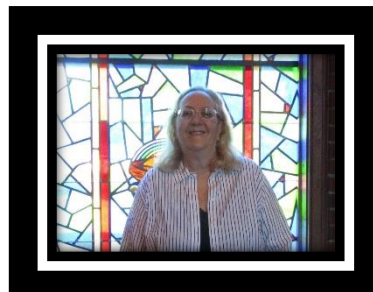
